## Voter Information Card (VIC)

This VIC tells you the times and places for voting and confirms that you are on the List of Electors. It's brighty yellow.
If you believe you are eligible to vote and do not receive your VIC by May 29 2009, please contact the Returning Office, at the telephone number below. If you are on the List of flectors and bring your VIC with you when you vote, the voting process will be easier.

You can still be added to the List of Electors if you are:

- 18 years of age or older on June 9, 2009
- a Canadian Citizen
- a resident of Nova Scotia since November 4, 2008

Personal identification is required.
Contact the Returning Office to fo find out how to be added to the List and the polling station at which you vote.

## ABSENTEE VOTING

Electors can vote by write-in ballot or at the Special or Advance polls, or on Election day. A write-in ballot is a blank ballot on which you write the name of the candidate for whom you are voting, or your party of choice. Write-in ballots are available from your local returning office now. If you are not on the List and want to vote by write-in ballot, you can be added to the List using the application for a write-in ballot and vote by mail or in person at the returning office.
