Lr. Onslow Community Centre to Spearhead Highway Clean-up

The Lower Onslow Community Centre under the direction of Doug MacInnes, Councillor for District 9, will be spearheading a highway litter clean-up on Saturday, May 7th. The decision was made at a meeting of the centre's board of directors on Sunday, January 17th.

According to MacInnes, the centre will be in contact with the Onslow-Belmont Fire Department, and other community groups to work together to do a ditch sweep of the highways to rid them of litter thrown from vehicles by passing motorists.

Although plans are not complete, the group plans to work with the elementary schools to get students involved to help create a higher awareness of the problem; use the student's influence on adults to help protect the environment, keep the highways cleaner.

Other community groups and individual residents are urged to contact members of the Lr. Onslow Community Centre directors to work together on a clean-up plan. MacInnes and other councillors are working with municipal staff to develop a highway clean-up initiative.
