Jason Fox Receives Prestigious FCM Award

Jason Fox, Town of Truro Director of Planning and Development Services, has been recognized by being awarded the 2017 Volunteer award by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities. He is being rewarded for providing significant technical assistance on urban planning issues in three missions as part of the Caribbean Local Economic Development (CARILED[1]) program.

He offered his extensive planning experience with partners in Belize and Jamaica, where his well thought out solutions and recommendations have proven useful in effectuating improved zoning and land usage practices in three communities visited over the past two years.

Among his main accomplishments, Jason Fox drafted revitalization plans for San Pedro and Belmopan, Belize and he worked with planners in Portmore, Jamaica to streamline their development approval process. In addition to designing physical and aesthetic

improvements to downtown streets public spaces he also recommended changes to regulations that would help facilitate ease of doing business by small businesses and local entrepreneurs.

Nyabigena Soapstone Carvers is a non-profit organization that provides life-changing opportunities in Kenyan communities. Located in Kisii, a city in western Kenya near Lake Victoria, Nyabigena is surrounded by high-quality soapstone quarries and is well-known for the expertise and talent of its carvers.

In addition to offering sustainable employment for its artisans, Nyabigena sponsors many community development projects such as management training workshops, educational opportunities for widows and orphans, women's literacy programs, and health and nutrition education. As part of their growing development initiatives, Nyabigena is planning to expand its

HIV/AIDS education programs and to establish a tree nursery to tackle the issue of deforestation in Kenya.

Ten Thousand Villages constantly works with artisans, who would otherwise be unemployed, or underemployed. These festival sales create opportunities for artisans in developing countries to earn an income by bringing their products and stories to our markets in North America.

This income helps pay for food, education, health care, and housing. Ten Thousand Villages works with over 120 different artisan groups from more than 30 countries across the globe.

"By holding this sale, we're giving customers in Truro, NS a chance to buy unique products while helping people in developing countries to meet basic needs for themselves and their family. Together we are making a difference," says Brenda Leenders, sale organizer.
