## New Restrictions to Increase Capacity

Dr. Robert Strang, Nova Scotia's chief medical officer of health, Premier Stephen McNeil and Minister of Health and Wellness Randy Delorey announced on March 18, measures to further prevent the spread of COVID-19 and increase capacity within the health system to respond.

Effective immediately: doctors and pharmacists have new options for virtual care, using telephone and secure videoconferencing; pharmacists can renew prescriptions for most medications and government will cover the assessment fee; employers cannot require a doctor's note if an employee must be off work; College of Physicians and Surgeons waiving the fee for retired doctors to renew their licenses so they can come back to work; retired and other nurses are being brought into the system to assist with 811 staffing and all

service providers funded through the Department of Community Services' Disability Support Program - including social enterprises, day programs, and supported employment programs for adults with diverse abilities will close to participants and the public Effective midnight Thursday, March 19, personal service and fitness establishments such as hair salons, barber shops, spas, nail salons, body art establishments and gyms were shut down.

Anyone who has travelled outside of Canada must self-isolate for 14 days when they return to Nova Scotia. If you have been in close contact with someone who has travelled and are experiencing fever (above 38 C) and/or new cough should complete the online questionnaire before calling 811.
