Clearing Saw Operator Training in May!

Clearing saw operator training will be held in two sessions, in the Western/Central and Eastern regions of Nova Scotia. Dates and Locations to be confirmed.

The training will provide participants with the skills required for a career as a silviculture worker and assist with retention of new workers. The ten-day program includes one day in-class and nine days hands-on at a PCT job site. Maximum of ten participants/session.

Training content will include: Clearing saw safety; Work planning and strip/block organization; Clearing saw operation and directional felling; Tree identification and crop tree selection; Quality control

and assessment; and Clearing saw maintenance and filing
