## Onslow Belmont Fire Brigade News

It has been a relatively quiet summer so far. Two recent incidents kept fire fighters on the go most of the night. On Sunday July 19 at approximately 10:00 pm, a call was received for a person trapped beneath a vehicle on Belmont Road.

A 39-year-old male is dead as a result of that mishap. Apparently the victim was

working under a vehicle when it collapsed on him. Firefighters and emergency personnel including RCMP were on the scene for a couple of hours.

Following that call, at 3 am on Monday morning a dispatch was received for a structure fire at 100 Onslow Mountain Road. The bi-level home owned by Mr. & Mrs. Charles Turner was extensively damaged by the blaze which appeared to start in the kitchen. The couple were awakened by one of their two dogs. There were no injuries. Firefighters remained on the scene until approximately 5:30 am. Debert, North River & Cobequid Fire Brigade's, provided mutual aid

Luckily with the wet conditions earlier, we had no major brush or woods fires. When we do get a few hot dry days, the fire risk increases rapidly so exercise caution at all times. Remember when you light a fire even on your own property it becomes your responsibility and you can be held accountable and liable for any

damage it causes. The best advise is don't light any fires.
