## 50th Wedding Anniversary DOUG AND BETTY CURRY

Recently the golden wedding anniversary of Doug and Betty Curry was celebrated at the Wentworth Recreation Centre with an attendance of over 160 people, consisting of relatives and friends of all ages. Everyone was greeted at the door by Doug and Betty's daughter, Diane Morin, and up on stage talented musician friends were playing music, "old-time" and popular, and at times singing songs. Food and drinks on long tables set up on one side were provided by the local United Church Women.

Both Betty and Doug are known for their successful careers and their volunteer contributions to the Wentworth community and elsewhere. Betty grew up in Wentworth and spent most of her growing years at the three story miners' hotel built around 1900 when there were two copper mines and a smelter in Wentworth. Later, the Ogilvie family turned the hotel into a store and after they left Wentworth, several owners took over the store, including Betty's father, Byron Patriquin. Betty attended the Wentworth one-room school until grade 11, attended Normal College for teachers in Truro,

attended Mount Allison University, became a teacher and principal in several Cumberland County schools, kept playing "old-time" music at dances with the Sunrise Serenaders and later with the Country Casuals, and married Doug Curry in 1961.

Doug matched Betty in fame in his job as manager and coach of the Cumberland Midget Minor AA Ramblers from 1970 right up to the present day. He has held numerous executive positions in minor hockey and helped organize Midget all-star games in both Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. For more than 40 years, Doug has been known as "Mr. Hockey" in Cumberland County. However, his talent is known beyond Cumberland County as a few years ago he received the prestigious President's New Brunswick Hockey Award.

In 2011 at Halifax received the equally prestigious President's Nova Scotia Hockey Award. In addition to hockey, Doug was manager and coach of the Wentworth Cougars baseball team for many years.

Their late son Byron had begun preparations for his parents' 50th wedding anniversary before he suddenly passed away at age 45.
