Nuts Are Good For Your Heart

Need a snack? Go nuts! Nuts can be good for your heart. They may lower low-density lipoprotein (LDL), or 'bad,' cholesterol levels. Eating nuts may reduce the risk of developing blood clots that can lead to a heart attack.

Try a small handful of nuts every day. Walnuts are rich in

omega-3 fatty acids. Almonds, macadamia nuts, hazelnuts and pecans are also very heart healthy.

Even peanuts, which are technically not a nut, but a legume, can be good for you. Of course, choosing nuts coated in chocolate, sugar or salt may cancel out their heart-healthy benefits.

13 Tropical Storms Anticipated

Hurricane season has begun and lasts until November 30. Although forecasters in the U.S. are predicting a "near-normal or below-normal" hurricane season for the Atlantic coast this year, there is still the potential for up to 13 tropical storms. What do you need to know about your insurance to be prepared?

Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) reminds consumers damage caused by these types of events is normally covered by home insurance policies, with the exception of overland flooding. If your property is damaged, it is

important to document any damages and check with your insurance representative as soon as possible.

Amanda Dean, IBC Vice-President, Atlantic, says, "In recent years, storms have caused a great deal of damage in our region as well as across Canada. Severe weather is the new normal for Canadians. But consumers can take steps to ensure now that they are properly covered and prepared before any storm hits."

Exploratory Drilling Program Slated for September/October

In last month's front page story, Stakeholder Gold Corp, a junior mining exploration company from Toronto, indicated it would begin exploratory drilling in the next few weeks. Since then Chris Berlet, president and CEO has reported its Bass River area exploratory drilling program will consist of four or five holes commencing in September or October.

Five to 10 workers, with a host of sophisticated equipment, including a diamond

drill, will conduct the exploratory drilling. Berlet anticipates a 5,000 to 10,000 metre program on specific targets.

The exploratory project is based on extensive analysis done by retired government geologist George O'Reilly on the Cobequid-Chedabucto Fault Zone. The fault zone, which divides the province's mainland from the Minas Basin through to Chedabucto Bay, is home to more than 100 mineral occurrences, according to O'Reilly's analysis.
