Wild blueberries are the #1 fruit crop grown in the province, accounting for more than half of the value of all fruit production in Nova Scotia. The farm gate value for the 2014 crop was over \$38 million.

Agriculture Minister Keith Colwell thanked the Federal Government for their co-operation with the funding and expressed his enthusiasm about the Program, especially the fact it is over three years.

"We want to keep our businesses here and keep our young people in Nova Scotia. I am tired of the young people leaving this province. What a wonderful place to live. What wonderful people we have here, and when we lose one of these young people, they often don't come back and we can't afford to have that."
