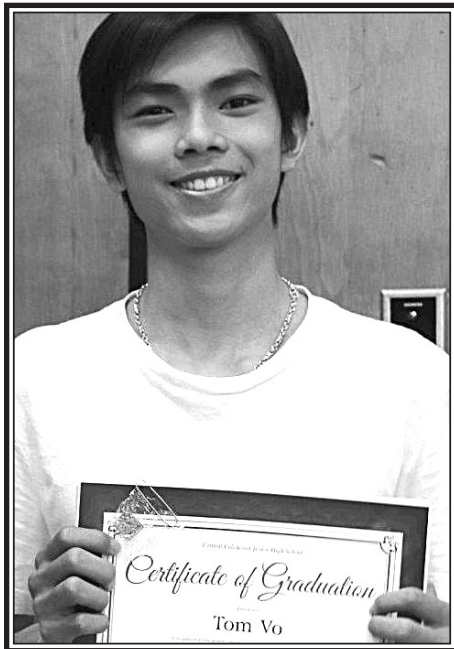

## 2018 Cobequid Trail Run – August 26<sup>TH</sup>

The 14th Annual Cobequid Trail run will be held on Sunday, August 26, 2018. The event will include a 5K, 10K & Half Marathon.

Whether you are new to running or trying to set a personal best, the Cobequid Trail Run has something for everyone. This out-and-back route on a flat and fast trail surface is a must-try event! The run route starts and finishes near the NSCC Truro Campus on Arthur Street and heads along the trail to Old Barns where the Cobequid Bay awaits you.

The Cobequid Trail Run will begin and finish on the Cobequid Trail located behind the NSCC Sport and Wellness Centre. The route is an out and back flat course heading westerly out of Truro on the trail.

Half Marathon begins at 8:30 a.m.; 5K and 10K runs start at 9:00 a.m. This is an Atlantic Chip Timing event, with chip start and finish.

Registration, continental breakfast and awards will take place at the NSCC Sport & Well-



ness Centre, 36 Arthur St., Truro. Washrooms, change rooms and showers located at the NSCC Sport and Wellness Centre are available to runners.

Registration fee includes t-shirt for all runners (to receive correct size register by Friday, August 3) & one breakfast ticket. Continental breakfast and award presentation will follow in the Gym.

No dogs permitted, with the exception of guide dogs. No strollers please. Youth will be running the same course at the same time as other participants.

## Tender Awarded for Village Line Sidewalk

The June 30th Colchester council meeting was the last one prior to council holidays for July. The next session of council will be council committee meeting on August 9th. The committee meeting will be preceded by a special council meeting at which time they will discuss amendments to the solid waste by-law (Seen council meeting notice elsewhere in this issue).

Under action items the land use by-law with respect to an application by Little Moe's K9 Academy in Bible Hill. The request is to remove the condition requiring accessory kennels and commercial boarding to be located outside Municipal Sewer District. The proposal, if approved, would accommodate the continued operation of the business at its Bible Hill location.

A public meeting on the matter will be held at council's monthly meeting on August 30th. According to the original plan, second reading would be held August 30th to receive a staff presentation and debate the matter.

Village Line Avenue sidewalk will be constructed following council awarding a \$557,895

tender to Atlantic Road Construction. Council's decision also includes a contingency of \$60,000 to be spent only on the authority of the Director of Public Works. Other bidders on the job included: S. W. Weeks Construction, \$587,030; Ian Sinclair Contracting, \$657,652; Dexter Construction, \$687,590; Brycon Construction, \$744,000; Basin Contracting, \$783,178 and W. Eric Whebbly, \$826,500.

In another tender award council gave authority to award a tender to Bruce Leasing in the amount of \$23,968.00, excluding HST, for a half ton truck for the Wastewater Treatment plant. Council were concerned about possible distances and associated costs for warranty work since the successful bidder was not from the area.

Council to give authority to August Council Committee to receive and approve the 2017/18 audited financial statements. On motions by Councillors Boutilier and Pash council gave approval to Mayoe Blair and Rob Simonds, CAO to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Department of Communities, Culture and Heritage.

Added to the evening's agenda for discussion and update was the Subject of tourism marketing levy. Council was informed there are ongoing meetings with Truro and Millbrook and things are moving in the right direction. In previous discussions, one municipal unit required clarification funds from the fund would be allocated throughout the county, so all areas would benefit.
