Two Advance Voting Dates

It took only 12 minutes for Colchester council to approve first reading of a new by-law which will add two additional days to advance voting days in October's municipal elections. Under provincial regulations, a new by-law was required to provide additional dates.

Second reading will be held at a council committee meeting on August 13th. Once the by-law is finally passed, voters will have four advance polling dates on October 8, 13, 14 & 15. If four dates are required in all districts the estimated cost is \$25,600 just to cover cost of advance polling.



As the term of the current council winds to a close, the following dates are posted for August and September: All meetings start at 6 pm unless otherwise noted, August 13, Council Committee; August 27, Council; September 10, Council Committee and September 24, Council. No dates have been posted for possible meetings in October.
