The pilot program will test technologies that are hybrid or alternative fuel options other than diesel only engines. The association is seeking companies to participate in a 2-year pilot program where technologies will be trialed and evaluated during commercial fishing seasons. The evaluation will include the assessment of fuel and energy use, an estimate of greenhouse gas emissions and overall operating costs which will include a cost benefit analysis.

PROPOSALS ARE TO CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Weight and space required for components
