
Diligent River's new monument, supplied by Heritage Memorials, was unveiled and dedicated on at 2012 Remembrance Day ceremonies. It was constructed earlier this year following a fund raising campaign by a local committee. Donations from Municipality of Cumberland, Veterans Affairs and the private sector made the installation possible.



A poppy cake was baked by Helen Bowden, Parrsboro at Crossroads Co-op for Diligent River's Remembrance Day services.



It took 70 years for Diligent River to get a monument to honour their veterans. Local veteran, Ron Colpitts, now in his 90's, served in WWII with the 4th Canadian Grenadiers Tank Division, was chosen to raise the flag at the unveiling and dedication ceremony and the area's first Remembrance Day services.
