What is Home Warming? Do you qualify?

Now that the days are getting colder and Jack Frost and howling winds will be here sooner than we want, it's time to ensure our homes are as winter proofed as much as possible. Unfortunately, some people are not so lucky keeping warm.

Speaking of keeping warm, I was approached by Sonia Smith - outreach@home-warming.ca - Tel: 902.818.1926 or 877.434.2136 to get the word out about Home Warming. So...What is Home Warming? We all deserve to be comfortable in our homes, regardless of income. For homeowners who qualify, the Home Warming team provides a comprehensive energy audit and works with you to determine the energy efficiency upgrades that make the most sense for your home.

Then the team takes care of managing sub-contractors to have the upgrades completed at no cost to you. The result? A more comfortable home in both winter and summer and more room in your household budget for other priorities.

Am I eligible? You can apply for the Home Warming program if: Your income is under the levels shown below; You own a single-unit home located in Nova Scotia and can provide proof of ownership; You live in your home year-round, it is your primary residence and you do not plan to sell it in the near future and Your home has not previously received upgrades through Home Warming or the Low Income Homeowner Service.

To be eligible, household income (from line 236 - Income Tax, Notice of Assessment, must be below these levels:
1 person, \$21,486;
2 to 4 people, \$39,367, or
5 or more people, \$56,064.

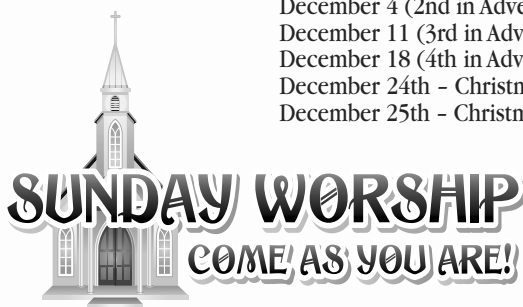
Church Services for December

Municipal Council Appoints Committee Members

At the November 25th meeting, municipal council accepted the recommendations of an internal nominating committee appointing members to its entire committee structure. Position appointments are four years, except for Deputy Mayor and Alternate Chair, which are selected annually by council. Duration of appointment to a committee is part of council policy, so council could make changes if so desired. The following is the committee structure: **Agriculture Working Committee:** One councillor - Deputy Mayor Masters; **Business and Economic Development Advisory:** Standing Appointment - Mayor Blair, plus three Council Members - Councillors Cooper, MacInnes and Parker. **Colchester East Hants Library Board:** Two Council Members - Councillors Boutilier and MacKenzie. **Citizens Monitoring - Kemptown:** Standing Appointment - Councillor Cavanaugh. **Dangerous and Unsanitary Premises:** Five Council Members - Councillors Boutilier, Gibbs, Gregory, MacInnes (Chair) and Taggart. **Debert Source Water Protection Advisory:** Standing Appointment - Mayor Blair, Deputy Mayor Masters and Councillor MacInnes. **Flood Advisory Committee:** Standing Appointment - Mayor Blair; Three Councillors - Boutilier, Gibbs and Cavanaugh (Chair). **Joint Flood Advisory Committee:** Two Council Members - Mayor Blair and Councillor Cavanaugh. **Joint Police Advisory Committee:** Two Council Members - Councillors Gregory and Parker. **Joint Planning Advisory Committee:** Standing Appointment - Mayor Blair and Councillor Taggart (as PAC Chair). **Livestock Control Advisory Committee:** Four Council Members - Councillors Cooper, Gibbs, Cavanaugh and MacInnes. **Northern Region Solid Waste Committee:** One Council Member - Councillor Taggart. **Planning Advisory Committee:** Standing Appointment - Mayor Blair and Deputy Mayor Masters, plus two Councillors MacInnes and Taggart (Chair).
