# Winter Driving Reminders

We also must prepare our "driving" selves! Here are a couple of winter driving reminders: Drive defensively and remember that you'll need a lot more room to stop than during the fall; Be aware of the road conditions and don't push it too hard on the highway.

Make sure to scrape all the snow and ice off your car before hitting the road; Keep an emergency kit in your car. At a minimum, it should have a blanket, flashlight and candle. Keep your car well-maintained as that will dramatically reduce your chances of suffering a mid-winter breakdown.

Give service vehicles and emergency responders the space to safely do their jobs. When we see emergency responders and service vehicles (such as roadside assistance

vehicles) on the road or highway with their lights flashing we know they are helping someone to safety.

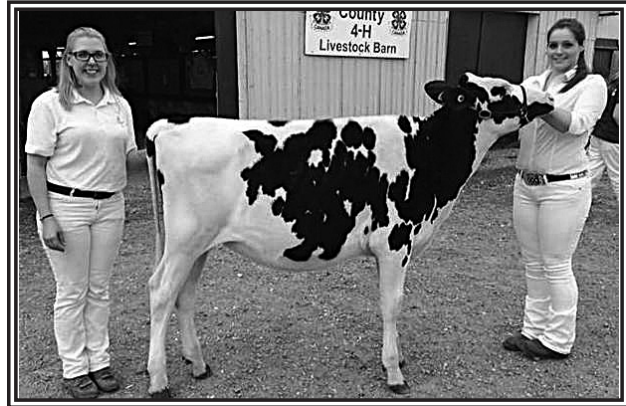
When we encounter these situations, how we react with our own driving plays an important role.

In Nova Scotia it is the law that drivers passing a stopped emergency vehicle with flashing lights most slow down to the speed limit or 60km/h (whichever is less), and must vacate the lane closest to the stopped vehicle, if it's safe to do so.

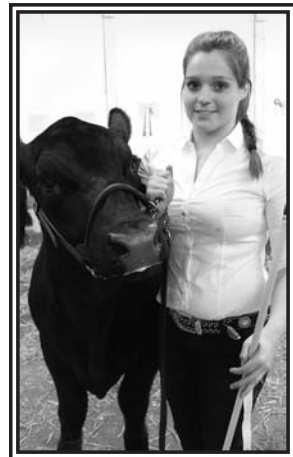
Let us protect those who go out to help those in need!
