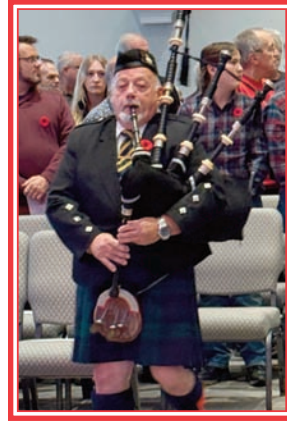

Quick Facts: Nova Scotia now has 136 parks designated under the Provincial Parks Act; Wilderness areas are designated under the Wilderness Areas Protection Act and nature reserves under the Special Places Protection Act.

The goal of protecting 20 per cent of Nova Scotia's land and water by 2030 is outlined in the Collaborative Protected Areas Strategy and Nova Scotia's protected areas conserve the province's biodiversity, unique habitats, coastlines, and natural landscapes and features while providing places for people to connect with nature; they also play an essential role in fighting climate change

Locally, Newly designated provincial parks include: Blue Sea Beach, Cumberland County; 177 hectares and Brule Shore, Colchester County; nine hectares.
