BALLET JÖRGEN • APRIL 11 • 7:30 PM • \$35

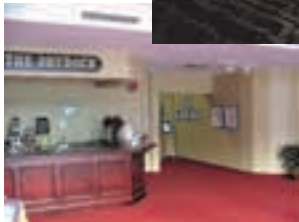
