2) Click on our website voting tool at [www.cehha.nshealth.ca](http://www.cehha.nshealth.ca) (note: only one vote per URL address (computer).

3) Complete a ballot at one of our Voting Stations

Ballot boxes will be hosted at Colchester Regional Hospital, Lillian Fraser Memorial Hospital, CEHHA's East Hants Resource Centre offices and other community venues.

The health authority is seeking a minimum of 1000 votes but is hoping to receive a much greater response.

The naming process was launched in March by a Community Advisory Committee established to foster input and dialogue on a variety of issues relating to the Colchester Regional Hospital Replacement Project. The Committee was seeking a name that: reflects the role of new facility; is not exclusive of any communities served;

creates and maintains a sense of pride and recognition; is not offensive to various religious beliefs, cultures or ethnic groups; is easy to read, pronounce and print; sounds credible; and results in acceptable acronym.
