Fire Brigade put on a "jaws of life" demonstration at their Annual Open House on July 18th. Spectators were asked to imagine the van had just been in an accident and had hit a pole. There was a victim trapped inside and the doors were jammed.

Fire fighters showed how airbags could be inserted under a vehicle, to raise it up, if a person was trapped underneath.

The demonstration proceeded with a great deal of glass breakage, as fire fighters removed all of the windows from the vehicle. They removed interior trim, looking for air bag activation points and cut any seatbelts.


The "jaws of life" have a force of 18,500 psi. It didn't take fire fighters Rob Stone and Gordon Myers long to force the door open and cut it right off the hinges, revealing victim Craig MacKay in the drivers seat, who had been covered by a protective blan-
