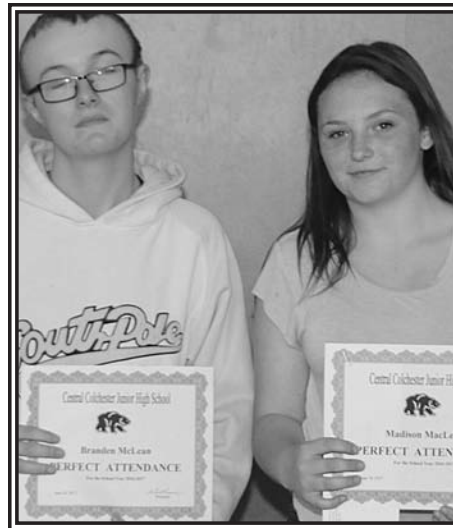


CENTRAL COLCHESTER JUNIOR HIGH AWARDS

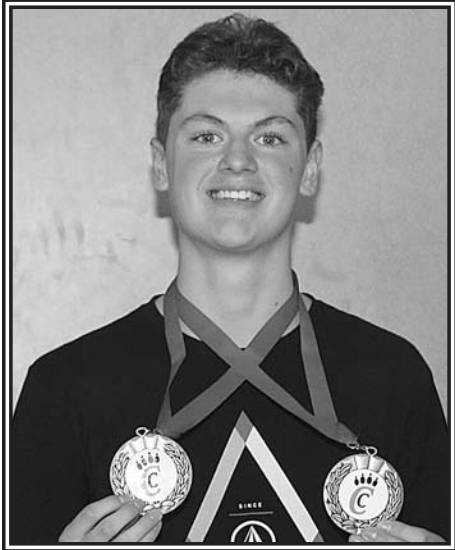

CCJHS Students Looking to Clean-up the Neighbourhood!

Have you seen any unsightly garbage dumped at locations in your community? It is the perfect time to have this cleaned up.

Central Colchester Junior High (CCJHS) students are looking to help clean-up their neighbourhoods this fall and coordinator Ross White would like people to let the school know of locations immediately. "We need time to have the sites inspected over the summer so everything is in place for the students this fall," says Mr. White, Vice President of the Trappers Association of NS.

Colchester Balefill & Composting Facility staff will visit the potential sites and make sure the areas are safe for the students to enter.

CCJHS will receive a \$8500 grant from the NS Hunter and Trappers Association once the clean-up work has been completed. This money will be going to help fund the school's Breakfast Program.

Mr. White says the grant is the brainchild of

Francis Gibbs, the Director for the Trappers Association of NS and has an open application process for any groups who may wish to apply.

The Association is pleased the grant money will be used for a project that is beneficial on so many levels. "It is good for the environment, creates awareness with youth, brings awareness to those who put the garbage on private land and hopefully the students will develop a sense of pride in improving a location for wildlife in their own communities," says White.

The project has attracted other supporters including Miller Waste Services, who are donating the use of dumpsters and waving the dumping fee, Tim Horton's, who will provide \$500 in food for the day and the Balefill staff, who as well as securing the locations will be doing presentations and a Balefill tour for the students.
