Sounds of the Ages - 3 Competitions – One Great Sound

If you're an upcoming musician or band searching for your big break, the Sounds of Ages Concert competition could be for you. The competition will be held at Colchester Legion Stadium on July 28th. Sponsored by Terry Sack of Terry's Tunes and Estate Jewellery and Pawn and coordinated by Haley Douglas, this competition could be your discovery opportunity and you have a chance to win some great prizes.

The first round of amateur competitions are for individuals ages 16 to 30's; second round is for individuals from

the ages 40's to senior ages and the third competition features groups from ages 16 to 30's.

In order to compete, entrants must go through an audition process. Auditions can be submitted with an on-line link, or done live. Details will be provided with the application form. Everyone competing must have their application /audition submitted by July 6th. Successful participants following auditions will receive notice on July 10, 2018. The competitors line-up will be released July 11th.

Sounds of Ages Concert to

be held Saturday, July 28th at Colchester Legion Stadium is open to the public starting at 11:55 pm. There will be a sliding admission fee from \$3.00 to \$5.00 per person. Children under the age of 11 years are free.

During the events there are a variety of activities for all ages, especially during set changes.

Schedule is: Starting at 1:10 pm to 1:43 pm there's Junior Open Mic. Auditions are not required for this event. Junior Open Mic is for youth and children under sixteen. Participants for this event will have signed up between 12noon and 12:30 pm at the Colchester Legion Stadium July 28th.

Competitions will be held from 1:55 pm to 5:50 pm. The schedule for the groups successfully completing the audition process earlier in July includes: #1 Competition, ages, 16-30's; # 2 Competitions for ages 40's - seniors. The final competition for the afternoon is # 3 for Groups in the age range of 16-30's. Announcement of Winners and Presentation of Prizes will be held 6:10pm - 6:52pm.

To enter any of the three competition categories email: sounds2K18@gmail.com to request an application form,

which must be submitted with an on-line audition link. Questions call 902-843-4130 and ask for Haley.

Competitors are required to submit an application form, supply an audio link of good sound quality. If you are unable to attach an audio link, please request a live audition be scheduled. The on-line audition must include one song per audition. The song must be a minimum of 3 minutes, not exceeding 5 minutes in total.

Language used in the audition song must be appropriate for all audiences. If chosen, the song used for your audition will be the song used in the competition, (exceptions may apply through song change inquiry).

There are limited numbers of spaces available for the competitions and there will be many auditions being received. We will be announcing all selected participants shortly after the audition submission date. Auditions will be accessed by judges separate from those judging the competitions. Age exceptions may be made in special cases.

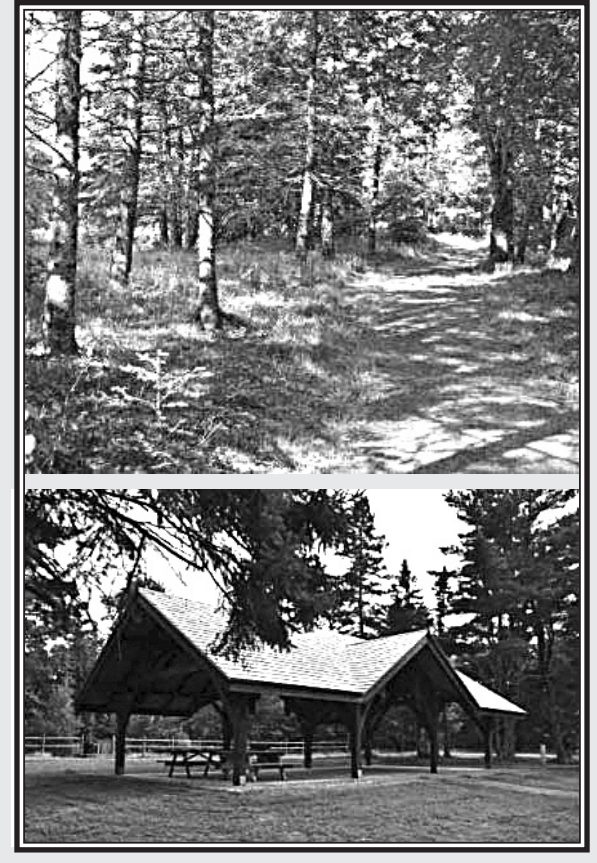

Discover Stewiacke River Park

This beautiful picnic park is a hidden gem beside the Stewiacke River. Enjoy this natural, forested park with mature pine, hemlock and spruce trees. Picnic with family or friends under the large timber frame picnic shelter or one of the many covered picnic tables.

Visitors can walk on the trail along the river and through the woods (total length 2 km). Rest at one of the benches along the paths.
