The Municipality of Colchester County's physical activity day camps will be traveling to Debert and Great Village this summer. Fun in the Sun Day Camp provides a week of fun outdoor activities, sports, theme days and lots more fun in the sun to keep kids active and smiling this summer. Each day, campers will participate in a variety of games and activities that follow the goal to promote physical activity and strengthen physical literacy among youth.

Fun in the Sun Day Camp also puts an emphasis on Sun Safety and incorporates the use of sunscreen and wearing appropriate clothing while being active outside this summer. We at Colchester Recreation want you to SLIP on a t-shirt, SLAP on a hat, and SLOP on some sunscreen while having fun in the sun.

The Classic Fun in the Sun Day Camp in Debert will be held at Debert Elementary on July 16th-20th. There will be lots of games, sports and activities that can be played both in the gymnasium, as well as on the playground equipment. Trail Blazers camp at Debert Elementary will be held August 13th-17th. Trail Blazer camps involve outdoor recreation, education and leadership activities focusing on getting youth outside and enjoying the outdoors.

Another Classic Fun in the Sun Day Camp will be held in Great Village at Great Village Elementary on July 23rd-27th. Camps run from 8:30am to 4:00pm. Lunches, snacks and lots of water must be provided by parents/guardians. The cost for the week is \$85 per child. We do offer family rates to accommodate families with multiple children who would like to attend camp. Fun in the Sun Day Camp is open to children ages 5 to 12; completion of grade primary is required.

Sam Moon's wealth of experience and awesome personality are what draw his following to him. Seeing Matt, Sam and Frank on the same bill, on the same day and the same stage will take your concert experience to a new level.

Bain Band hits the stage again on Saturday evening after warming up the crowd on Friday.

The band, Tribute has been on the scene since the 80's. For those of you who have not heard of Tribute you are in for a surprise. It will be about the Harmonies and Beatles tunes. This is a group of musicians that have played the circuit with well-known acts throughout their careers.

Wrapping up Saturday night is the Headliner, the legendary, Matt Minglewood. His latest edition to the resume, Entertainer of the Year as voted by the fans at ECMA'S.

This concert is a don't miss with rock, blues, country, Celtic and so much more, the best of Atlantic Canada's talent on one stage.

The venue is up close and personal with less than five hundred concert goers. Located on 18 Wildflower Lane in River John, the action takes place under a MacFarland's 40 by 80 tent, rain or shine.
