According to the headline story in the May issue, Colchester's response to Indigenous Services Canada - Atlantic Region was due June 7th however the submission date has been pushed back until July 19th, according to Adrienne Murray, Land Management Advisor.

Murray's original letter dated April 8th request response by June 7th whereas it

should have provided a deadline of July 7th.

Millbrook First Nation, by way of a Band Council Resolution, submitted a request for a Reserve Creation to Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) to add 942 acres to its existing 720 acres. Millbrook has acquired 13 parcels of land and has requested the lands be set apart as "Millbrook Indian Reserve No 27D".
