## Subsea Mooring Buoys Deployed

On June 1st and 2nd, FORCE deployed 12 yellow subsea mooring buoys in the Minas Passage, using the Nova Endeavor operated by Huntley's Sub-Aqua Construction (Kentville, NS). The subsea buoys house acoustic receivers which detect tagged fish in the area. Fish species that may be picked up by the receivers include Alewife, American Eel, American Shad, Atlantic Salmon, Atlantic Sturgeon, Atlantic Tomcod, Spiny Dogfish, Striped Bass, and White Shark.


This work is part of a risk assessment program (RAP) for tidal energy, which involves building a large data set of fish movement in the Bay of Fundy. The project is a collaborative effort between Acadia University, the Fundy Ocean Research Centre for Energy, Marine Renewables Canada, the Mi'kmaw Conservation Group, and the Ocean Tracking Network at Dalhousie University.


To ensure the health and safety of staff and surrounding communities where people live and work, FORCE has been operating in accor-
