## Public Invited to Grand Opening

The public is invited to a special Grand Opening of the Greville Bay Fitness Park in Port Greville June 29. The 11 a.m.-2 p.m. event, featuring music, games and food, will officially open the park, which was started several years ago but the Covid virus prevented an official ceremony.

During the event, special recognition will be given with the unveiling of a memorial to Steve Vickery who, with wife Kim, donated the acreage that

houses the park in 2018.

The Grand Opening will feature free barbecued food, a chance to try the equipment and/or the walking trail and music. The activities for the day will include washer toss, bean bag toss, and a rock hunt for the children.

The park, which features several pieces of outdoor exercise equipment and a walking trail, as well as a washroom and picnic tables, is free for all to use, even in winter. ## RCMP seek Garnett Chappell

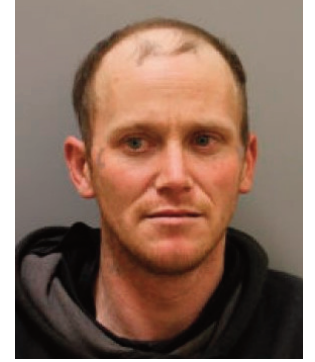

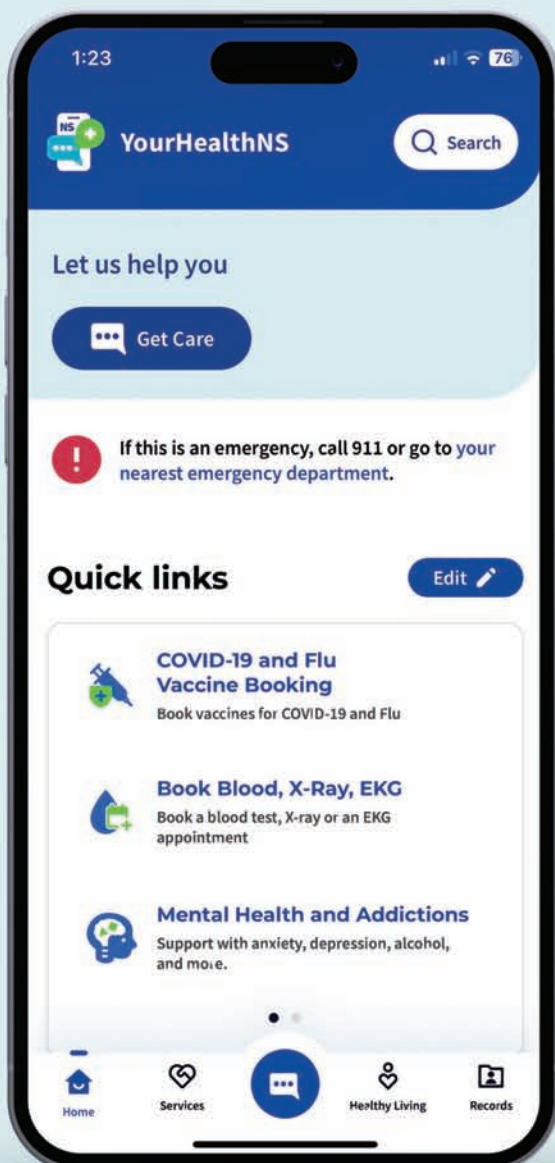
