The Provincial Fire Services Long Service Medal is awarded to any person who is serving or, within the previous three

years, has served as a firefighter for twenty-five years. The Fire Services Long Service Medal is a circular 1 3/8" diameter rhodium plated metal bearing the Maltese Cross, superimposed with the Coat of Arms of Nova Scotia and the inscription "Fire Services Nova Scotia" and on the reverse the inscription "For Long Service". The medal is suspended by a ribbon with seven stripes, three

mined by the advisory committee". A person who has been awarded the Medal is eligible to be awarded a Bar for each additional 10-year of service.

The Fire Services Exemplary Service Medal consists of a circular medal with a stylized maple leaf bearing a fire hydrant with crossed axes and a Maltese Cross, circumscribed with the words"Exemplary Service - Services Distingués", and on the reverse, the Royal Cipher. The Medal is suspended by a ribbo of five equal stripes, two gold and three red. The Bar to the Medal consists of a plain bar with a stylized maple leaf.
