

## Steele commits to Plymouth State University

The Truro Bearcats have announced that defenseman Josh Steele has committed to Plymouth State University, an NCAA Division III program.

The 20-year-old from Odessa, Florida spent two seasons in the Maritime Junior Hockey League (MHL). He joined the Summerside Western Capitals for the start of the 2021-22 season and registered two assists in ten games before being dealt to Truro in December. From there, Steele had one goal and eight assists in sixteen games to end the regular season.

He scored twice and added six assists for the Bearcats in the playoffs as they advanced to the league final. He was named to the Eastlink South Team of the Week once.

In 2022-23, Steele was sixth in scoring among MHL defensemen at 38 points with ten goals and 28 assists and was named to the Eastlink South's Team of the Week twice. In the Metalfab MHL Cup Playoffs, Steele had one assist in nine games.

## Humber-Dredge commits to Wisconsin-Stout

The Truro Bearcats have announced that forward Tanner Humber-Dredge has committed to the University of Wisconsin-Stout, an NCAA Division III program.


The 20-year-old from St. John's, Newfoundland was selected by the Bearcats in the 6th Round, 89th overall, in the 2020 MHL Entry Draft. In his rookie season of 2020-21, Humber-Dredge tallied three goals and nine assists in 29 games for Truro. He also played in five playoff games.

In 2021-22, Humber-Dredge was fourth in team scoring with 31 points as he registered 9 goals and 22 assists in 36 games. During Truro's march to the league final, he was tied for second in team

scoring with six goals and seven assists. Humber-Dredge was named an Honourable Mention for the MHL's Top Forward in February 2022 and was named to the Eastlink South Team of the Week once.

Humber-Dredge picked up his scoring prowess even more in his final season, leading the Bearcats with 68 points. His 49 assists also led the team, to go with nineteen goals. In the Metalfab MHL Cup Playoffs, he also had one goal and seven assists in seven games. Humber-Dredge was named to the Eastlink South's Team of the Week six times in 2022-23.

## 2023 MHL Entry Draft to be broadcast on Eastlink Community TV

Truro, N.S. (May 23, 2023) - The Maritime Junior Hockey League (MHL) is pleased to announce that Eastlink Community TV will carry the 2023 MHL Entry Draft. The first two rounds of the event will be broadcast live on Thursday, June 15th starting at 7 p.m. on channels 10 and 610 in Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and Newfoundland.

Join host Mavs Gillis and draft analysts Dan Hobson, Greg MacDonald, and Mike Smith as they break down the selections from the MHL's twelve teams. Coverage on Eastlink will include interviews with players, coaches, and general managers.

The 2023 MHL Entry Draft will once again be held online, powered by HockeyTech and Rinknet, with fans able to see each selection as they're made at themhl.ca or through the league's social media accounts in addition to the live coverage on Eastlink Community TV.

The newly relocated West Kent Steamer franchise has the 1st overall selection, followed by the Amherst Ramblers, Fredericton Red Wings, and Grand Falls Rapids. The full draft order will be posted on themhl.ca closer to draft day.

The draft consists of 10 rounds in total, two of which are territorial selections. Teams can each make up to two territorial selections, draft picks from their area, and teams that do not are given compensatory selections after the 2nd and 3rd rounds, respectively. These selections will be announced before the draft.

## Yarmouth's season comes to an end with a quarterfinal loss at the 2023 Centennial Cup

The Yarmouth Mariners' spectacular season came to an end late Friday night in Portage la Prairie, Manitoba as the Maritime Junior Hockey League (MHL) champions lost 2-1 to the host Portage Terriers in the 2023 Centennial Cup quarterfinals.

Yarmouth outshot the Terriers 37-31 for the game, including 14-5 in the 3rd period, but two Portage powerplay goals proved

to be the difference on the scoreboard. Franco Canevari was credited with a goal for Yarmouth after the Terriers knocked the puck behind their own goaltender. It was the lone blemish on the night for Bailey Monteith, who made 36 saves including several spectacular stops in the 2nd and 3rd periods as Yarmouth kept pressing in 5 on 5 play. Keegan Warren was named Player of the Game for Yarmouth, as he

made 29 saves in the loss. Reilly Mayne (3G, 1A) and Ben Roode (4A) finished with four points each to lead Yarmouth at the Centennial Cup. In all, fifteen of Yarmouth's 20 skaters registered a point at the tournament.
