The low income property tax exemption for 2017 has increased 1.3% over 2016. The following are the income levels and exemption amounts for 2017: Family of 1, less than \$25,006, \$188.89; family of 2,

less than \$33,028, \$251.85 and family of 3 or more, less than \$39,632, \$314.82.

The amounts were announced in an information item circulated to council at the February 15th council committee meeting.

sale of our buildings stays in our coffers for us to use to keep up our remaining building.

Toothache: What you can do?

If you have a toothache, see your dentist ASAP. In the meantime, rinse your mouth

with warm water and use dental floss to try to remove any food particles wedged between your teeth. Take an over-the-counter pain reliever to dull the ache.

You can also try applying oil of cloves (eugenol) or an antiseptic containing benzocaine directly to the irritated tooth and gum for temporary pain relief. I find that Orrigel works well!

Don't place aspirin or another painkiller directly against your gums; it may burn your gum tissue.
