Cape Sharp will deploy in mid-2018

In an update released on February 20th Cape Sharp Tidal will deploy their in-stream tidal turbine in mid-2018 at the FORCE test site. In the update, Stacey Pineau said the company is building on success in every part of this demonstration project; are working to apply what was learned from the previously deployed turbine and environmental monitoring devices that were recovered in June 2017. Cape Sharp Tidal is continuing to improve technology and increasing the turbine's operating efficiency.

Later this spring, they will use a heavy lift vessel to place the turbine on the purpose-built Scotia Tide Barge in preparation for deployment. This vessel will be used to remove the "wet" turbine from the Scotia Tide and then to lift the "dry" turbine from the quay onto the barge.

The company's first annual environmental monitoring report is now

available on the Cape Sharp Tidal website, along with three previous quarterly reports. The update continued with a commitment to sustainable in-stream tidal development and they are working with local and international scientists, universities and independent research and technology companies to reach their goal of increased knowledge and environmental protection.

Referring to the Government of Canada Ocean Supercluster (OSC) announcement of the \$950-Million innovation supercluster initiative will give in-stream tidal developers like Cape Sharp Tidal the opportunity to attract potential technology partners. OSC will help foster and enable innovation in the tidal energy industry, allowing it to stay at the forefront of emerging technologies and creating a more sustainable ocean energy industry.

The update concluded with "As we plan for our next deployment in mid-2018, we'll continue to engage with stakeholders and Indigenous communities regarding our plans".
