The Capital Plan 2020-21 also includes \$385.3 million in investments outlined in the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal's Five-year Highway Improve-

ment Plan. Capital Plan 2020-21 includes the design and construction of 16 schools and the purchase of 30 P-3 schools; major infrastructure investments include a new NSCC Marconi campus, the

Waterfront Art District in Halifax, and a road plan that includes twinning Highway 104.

The capital plan is subject to approval of the 2020-21 budget in the Legislature.
