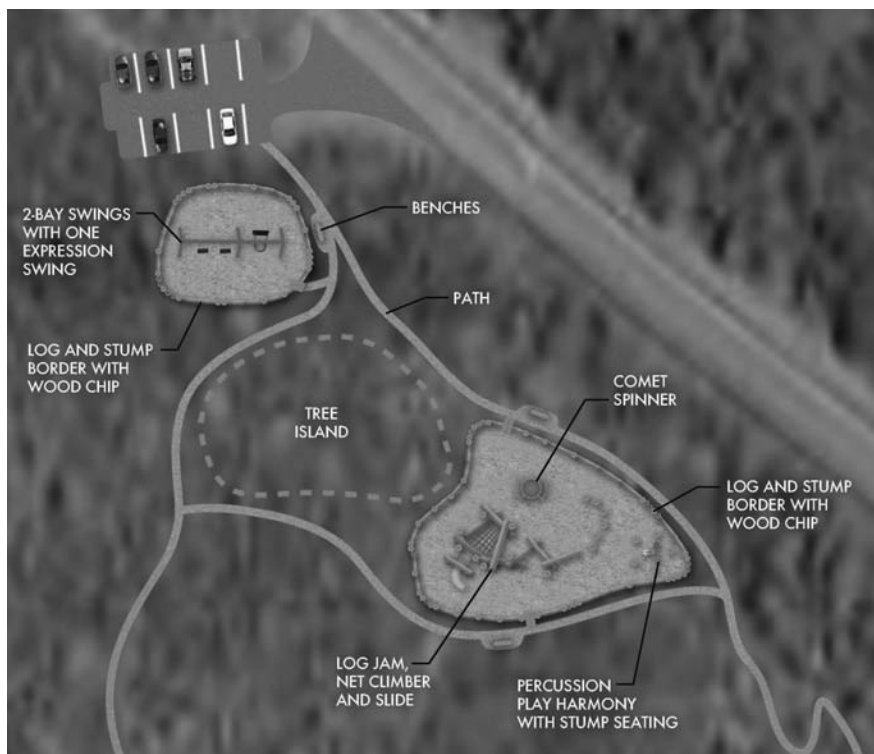

Heart's Haven Memorial Park, Debert - Update

This is an update on the Heart's Haven Memorial park, planned for Debert which has been in the planning process since late 2020.

At the January 28, 2021 meeting, Council passed a motion to support the creation and design of a memorial park and playground in Debert with assistance from staff. The request to create a park on Municipal land along Plains Road came at the request of the Beaton and O'Brien families.

The following are some of the highlights in bullet form which were presented to Colchester Council on January 27th:

- The park concept was created with direct input from the families, as well as site visits to the property. Staff retained Cobequid Consulting to create the drawings.

- The vision for the park is a welcoming public space for all ages in a natural setting for reflection, remembrance, play, relaxation and overall wellness. The design includes a focus on nature, accessibility and inclusion, creation of a community destination, sustainability, and supporting local. The families suggested the park name, which has special meaning.

- Proposed layout and amenities: The park will

have two areas - a garden area on the east side of the brook in memory of Heather O'Brien, and a playground area on the west side of the brook in memory of Kristen Beaton. A crusher-dust walking trail (1.5 km) with two loops will connect these areas, and a bridge will cross the brook.

- The playground will have unique traditional and natural play elements including swings, climbers, logs, and music flowers. The garden area will include paths through plantings of favourite flowers and shrubs, a gazebo (already in place), small picnic shelter and picnic tables.

- Benches will be placed in the garden, beside the playground, along the trail and beside the brook. Parking areas will be available near the playground and garden. Signage will include an entrance sign, civic address, site orientation, trail wayfinding and donor/supporter recognition.

- Estimated project cost is at least \$240,000.00. Currently, community members are sourcing donations (cash and in-kind) for the project. Staff are preparing a Recreation Facility Development funding application to the Province. Construction is tentatively planned to begin summer 2022, if sufficient funding is in place.
