Vintage Aircraft to Visit Debert – May 20

The skies over Truro and Debert will host some distinguished guests on the morning of Saturday, May 20th 2017. Five replica World War One biplanes, fresh from their Vimy Ridge centenary fly-past, will grace us with their presence.

They are the centerpiece of a special event being organized by the Truro Flying Club out of their Debert Airport home. It's being described as a "family day of flight and remembrance" by the Club's President Val Kyte.

"We are honoured that they have chosen us as one of their stops following their tribute at Vimy and want to share this with the whole community" he said.

The Debert Airport, which is managed for the County of Colchester by the Truro Flying Club, is considered by many to be the premium facility in Nova Scotia for recreational pilot training. Both the County and The Truro Flying Club intend to get that secret told and see the May 20th event as a great starting point.

While the main attraction will be the three Nieuport Elevens and two Sopwith Pup aircraft, the day will offer much more. A ¾ sized Spitfire, so prominent in the Second World War, will also be on hand. Two local classic car clubs have signed on to display their member vehicles. Specialty food trucks will be on site and numerous displays are planned.

Truro Flying Club members will also have their

many diverse airplanes on display. And not all of them will be grounded. The Club will be offering 30 minute flights throughout the day for a charge of \$100 for up to two passengers. Specific flight times can be booked ahead by calling 902-662-2228.

The Debert Airport, which is part of the Debert Business Park, is located at 44 Spitfire Road in Debert. The event runs from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m..
