The Legge Health Inc award for 15 and under female athlete of the year award was presented to Olivia Krzywonos by Legg's representative, Jill Legge.

Outstanding Female Athlete 15 Years and Under Olivia Krzywonos - Soccer / Volleyball / Track and Field

Olivia is a highly talented multi-sport athlete. During the 2017 soccer season Olivia was a dominant force for the Halifax-Dunbrack Soccer Club which placed second at the Nova Scotia Provincial Championships. Her skills and scoring touch was recognized by soccer Nova Scotia and Olivia was named to the U-14 Nova Scotia Provincial Team. In March the squad travelled to Vancouver and competed against the top teams in Western Canada. The team was undefeated at the tournament due in no small part to Olivia's vaunted offense. In the fall, Olivia was named to the Soccer Nova Scotia Provincial Development Squad.

During her NSSAF school soccer season Olivia led the Bible Hill Junior High Huskies to an undefeated season, capturing both the District and Regional titles. In the 2017 Track and Field season, Olivia advanced to the NSSAF Provincial Championships in the 200m, 400m, long jump and triple jump. In the 2017 NSSAF Volleyball season Olivia led the Huskies to the Regional Final. Despite her outstanding accomplishments in multiple sports Olivia's outstanding character and leadership skills are highlighted by her coaches. She is the type of athlete that impresses coaches and fans both on and off the field.
