A variety of educational programs regarding Waste diversion were held through the year, which included: Lunch & learn presentation at the Best Western Glengarry on recycling was given to the Rotary Club of Truro with several questions and concerns on where the recyclables are actually going. A presentation on how illegal dumping cases are handled in Colchester was given at the Annual General Meeting of the Adopt Highway. Representatives from across the province attended.

During Waste Reduction Week a Lunch & Learn took place at the Truro Farmer's Market with local businesses sharing how they made business decisions to implement the 3 R's focusing on reduction and reuse. The theme was how to Reduce Single Use. Presentation and sorting relay games with Cubs and Beavers was very popular activity.

Other activities included Information booth at the Stewiacke Business Expo; Joint effort with Sobey's Dietician, Jennifer Ferguson, at a lunch and learn on how to avoid food waste. Elementary schools were part of the education program including: Harmony Heights Elementary School to the Grade 3 class; Brookfield Elementary to the Grade 4 class; Bible Hill Junior High Career Fair where there was 75 community representatives and 320 Grade 8 & 9 students participated.

A facility tour took place with the West Colchester Consolidated School with 40 grade

7 to 9 students in attendance; Community presentation to the Old Barns Firemenettes; Dalhousie University Engineering students had a full solid waste site tour; Presentations to Army Cadets at the Truro Armories and Colchester Solid Waste Facility Tour with the Bible Hill Grade 9 - Discovering Opportunities class and they also toured Subway Bottle Exchange and the Divert NS Warehouse.
