Commemorative Medal Created for Queen's Platinum Jubilee

Lt.-Gov. Arthur J. LeBlanc has announced the establishment of the Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee Medal (Nova Scotia). The medal program marks the unprecedented 70th anniversary of the Queen's accession to the throne in 1952 and honours significant contributions and achievements by Nova Scotians.

Five thousand medals will be awarded across the province through February 5, 2023. The Department of Intergovernmental Affairs' Protocol and Honours Secretariat, in partnership with the Office of the Lieutenant-Governor, will administer the program. Provincial stunting statistics for March 2022

In an effort to keep citizens informed about enforcement on our roadways, the RCMP is releasing statistics on stunting charges monthly. In March 2022, the Nova Scotia RCMP charged 5 drivers with stunting on a number of highways across the province. The following drivers were caught traveling at speeds that caused significant concern: 177 km/h in a 110 km/h zone on Highway 104 in Salt Springs; 165 km/h in a 110 km/h zone on Highway 102 in Brookfield; 164 km/h in a 70 km/h zone on Highway 4 in Glenholme; 161 km/h in a 100 km/h zone on Highway 101 in Grand Pre and 118 km/h in a 60 km/h zone on Highway 1 in Weymouth.

Stunting is defined as any person who operates a motor vehicle on a highway in a race, in a contest, while performing a stunt or on a bet or wager. Anyone driving a motor vehicle 50 Km/hr or more, over a speed limit, may be charged with stunting. The fine for stunting in Nova Scotia is \$2,422.50 for a first offence, six points on your license and an immediate seven-day roadside license suspension.

Speed is one of the major causes of serious injury and fatal collisions on our roads. Road safety is a priority for the RCMP and drivers are reminded to make it their priority as well. If you see someone driving unsafely on our roads, please report it by calling the RCMP at 1-800-803-RCMP (7267). If you believe it is an emergency, call 911.
