## Wentworth Recreation Centre

On the last Sunday of the month (except December), a Music Afternoon is held at the Wentworth Recreation Centre. The music is performed by many volunteer musicians coming from many places in Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, and they play dance music Down East style which is a combination of differing styles formed into a melodious amalgam of tunes from Scotland, Ireland, Wales, England, Cape Breton, Acadia, Quebec, New England States (USA) and modern day tunes (such as Dave Bagnell's Michelle's Waltz).

The Wentworth Recreation Centre was built during the years 1988 to October 1990 for a price of \$500,000 and a hardwood floor was installed, after more funding was raised. The official opening date was September 21, 1991, and participating at the opening was Betty Curry who is now past-Chair of the Recreation Centre executive and a director of the Sunday Music Afternoons.

Among the musical instruments played are the fiddle, piano, drums, guitar, banjo, double bass, saxophone, and spoons. At times, songs are performed in a style for dancing. The dancing is inclusive and is mostly done free style instead of in square dancing format, although on occasion an occasional square dance and waltz quadrille are thrown in. As well as couples attending, singles also come and find dancing partners on site. Dances performed are waltzes, polkas, hop-polkas, fox trots, jigs and reels. Favourite tunes fill the hall such as Orange Blossom Special, Big John McNeil, St. Anne's Reel, Maple Sugar, Shingle the Roof, Old Man and Old Woman, Snowflake Breakdown, Squirrel in the Tree, Mason's Apron, High Level Hornpipe, etc.

Robert Taylor, a fiddler from Dartmouth who often comes to the Music Afternoon, writes in his book, Beyond the Music: "Keep tunes simple and, above all, learn to play good dance music...music is the lifeblood of all of us...Playing in Wentworth has always been one of my personal favourites. There is a great hall there...fiddlers come from all over to take part...They have a wonderful facility and people really enjoy the dancing."

Everyone is asked to bring food which is arranged in the kitchen for a potluck lunch at 4 pm. The Centre has one of the best large hardwood floors in Nova Scotia. Whenever a section may need repair, it can be done locally. Anyone who knows dancing well will agree that a hardwood floor is the best for dancing.

Some members of the Recreation Centre are saying that a floor of tiles would be better than a hardwood floor which needs repairs at times. That idea is a tragedy for those who enjoy the Music Afternoon and dancing, and the Music Afternoon would be forced to shut down. It is important to keep the hardwood floor in place at the Recreation Centre and to keep the wonderful Sunday Music Afternoons continuing into the future. The next business meeting at the Recreation Centre is on Thursday, November 6, at 7 pm.

It is interesting to know that the popular TV show "So You Think You Can Dance" is filmed at a Los Angeles Dance Studio which uses hardwood floors in all of its studios.
