HOSPITAL COMPUTER SYSTEM UPGRADE

Nova Scotia's hospital computer information system is scheduled for a **required** upgrade on November 4 and 5, 2014. **During these two days Colchester East Hants Health Authority facilities will be operating at emergency/urgent levels only.**

Due to the upgrade, all **walk-in clinics** including **Diagnostic Imaging and Lab Blood Collection Services WILL NOT be provided on November 4 & 5** at the Colchester East Hants Health Centre, Lillian Fraser Memorial Hospital, Lloyd E Matheson Centre and all Satellite clinics.

The hospital computer system will not be available during the upgrade so patients may experience delays in registration.

To minimize delays, please ensure you have your Nova Scotia health card when accessing health services.
