## Excellence in Community Development

They believe in giving back to the community that they service and have contributed financially to minor sports, Marigold Cultural Center, S.P.C.A and the Canadian Red Cross over the past years.

This year they are contributing to the Truro Homeless Outreach Shelter, both with labour and materials, along with the help of Eddy Group Ltd and Mircom Engineering Systems (fire alarm).

They take pride in being a long-time business operating in Truro attributing excellent customer service for their longevity.
