The Excellence in Community Development Award is designed to recognize a business, community organization or social enterprise that has made significant and notable contributions to their community (cultural, social, environmental and/or economic) and one that serves as a catalyst for positive action, exhibiting the highest standards of leadership. Brian Appleby on behalf of Aggregate Equipment Atlantic Ltd received the 2018 Excellence in Community Development Award.


Aggregate Equipment Atlantic Ltd. is a supplier to the construction and mining industries of Atlantic Canada. They supply parts, sales, and service for crushing, screening, paving, drilling and conveying equipment.

Established in 2001, The company employs 43 people full-time, year round. Its home base is in Truro, with a second location in St. John's, NL, and a salesforce based out of Fredericton, NB. Over the last six years they have expanded their staff by 50 per

cent to better serve their customers. They contribute approximately \$ 2.7 million dollars in payroll directly to our region's economy each year.

Aggregate Equipment has contributed to the social fabric of our community through their support of several recent capital campaigns; \$30,000 to the new hospital, \$30,000 to the RECC, and this year \$25,000 to Colchester East Hants branch of the Canadian Mental Health Association's new building fund. They are also long-time supporters of Third Place Transition House, Rotary House, and Hospice.

Each December the Aggregate Equipment staff assemble and deliver a full Christmas food & gift basket for three families for the Christmas Index. Aggregate Equipment has been a Corporate Sponsor of the Marigold Cultural Centre at \$2,500 per year for the past 5 years, and have signed on to sponsor the "Rock Recording of the Year" Award for each of the three years that Nova Scotia Music Week is taking place in Truro.

Small Business Achievement

This award is given to a local entrepreneur who has been in business for more than 10 years, who is continually modifying to adapt to changing technologies. The award is sponsored by Price-waterhouse Cooper.

Shelley Roy and Paul Blenkhorn on behalf of Blenkhorn's Auto Recyclers Ltd accepted the 2018 Small Business Achievement Award.

Since 1965, Blenkhorn Auto Recyclers Ltd has been serving customers in Truro and Colchester. There are currently 14 employees working at their Brookside location serving body shops, service garages and retail customers.

Their main business is automotive recycling. They purchase damaged and end of life vehicles, stripping them of parts for resale. They also market new auto parts and sell used vehicles, along with campers and camper parts. Throughout the recycling process, they pride themselves on keeping their premise very neat, clean and tidy promoting environmental stewardship at every turn. They truly care about the quality they provide and about meeting

environmental standards, achieving a world Gold Seal Recycler status.

Safety of staff and customers is also vitally important to this business. They ensure recalled auto parts removed from vehicles are sent for proper disposal so they are not resold. They send thousands of tires to the province's tire recovery program and crushed vehicles are processed by local metal handler John Ross and Sons, sent for new product manufacturing.

They offer delivery in the local area daily, as well as to locations in metro. They are also exporters, shipping parts across Canada. They are members of national and international recognized automotive and business organizations and are long-time members of the Truro & Colchester Chamber of Commerce.

A community supporter in many ways, they donate to several organizations within Colchester such as fire brigade auctions and have a long-term lease with the Municipality of the County of Colchester for the walking trails passing through their property.

Their creative helpful staff work with customers to provide the perfect arrangement or gift for any special occasion.
