

Television productions receive funding

Funding commitments to two productions have been made through the Eastlink TV Independent Production Fund Program. Applications were received between May 25 and June 22 and were decided upon by the Nova Scotia Independent Production Fund's board of directors. Funding commitments totalling \$330,000 have been approved for the following projects: TV series Mr. D Season 8, produced by Mr. D S8 Productions Limited will receive \$165,000. The show stars Jonathan Torrens, Onslow. The TV series Pure Season 2, produced by Pure Season 2 Inc., was awarded \$165,000.

Highest credit rating ever

Nova Scotia has received its highest-ever credit rating from Standard and Poor's bond-rating agency. The agency cited strong fiscal management as it upgraded the province's long-term credit rating from A+ to AA- with a stable outlook. In the agency's credit report, it notes the province is expected to outperform most Canadian provinces in the next two years, with strong management practices translating into solid budget outcomes.

A reverse trade show "Building Business Opportunities between Government and Suppliers" will be held at Mount Saint Vincent University on November 7th. Great White Sharks are Here!

Nova Scotia on the weekend of September 14th. They expect to spend approximately three weeks looking for sharks. They hope to tag mature females and track them to a birthing site. Some believe as waters get warmer and food sources move around, it could be possible the great whites are using Nova Scotia waters for birthing.

On Wednesday evening, September 19th, the M V Ocearch sailed out of Lunenburg heading for the Cross Island area where there is an abundance of seals, the preferred diet of great whites.

Ocearch is best-known in Nova Scotia for tagging Hilton, a celebrity, great white shark who frequently visits the Mahone Bay area. Satellite tracking has shown instead of Mahone Bay area, Hilton is now hanging around off Cape Breton.

Some researchers think Hilton could be going after food, moving with temperature changes or he could have been forced out of the area around Mahone Bay by a bigger shark competing for what may be a mating territory. Other researchers have suggested Hilton could have grown big enough, himself, to barge into territory he was not able to get to in previous years.

The On Thursday, we expedition successfully tagged a three metre juvenile male, believed to be about 20 years old. The tag applied to the shark will pop off in about nine months. When it pops off the shark the tag will float to the surface and transmit information to a satellite. The tag will have recorded data relating to location, depth of water, temperature, food sources and proximity to the coastline.
