weeks, and once the team and the regulators are satisfied that the systems are working well, blades will be installed on the turbines and generation will commence.

Jason Hayman, Managing Director of SME, who is leading the project, commented: "It is fantastic to have PLAT-I redeployed in Nova Scotia so quickly after her initial trials in Scotland. We have been very impressed with the capabilities and positive 'can do' attitude of all of the companies in Nova Scotia who have contributed to getting PLAT-I deployed in Grand Passage.

A.F.Theriault was responsible for assembling and launching the system. They did an amazing job - really going above and beyond to make this happen so quickly. The same is true of Mike Huntley's team, and the capabilities and

enthusiasm demonstrated by the skippers of the fishing vessels that were an integral part of the operation was amazing.

It really does show that tidal energy can be delivered

using local assets, and create real value for coastal communities. As the project evolves we look forward to demonstrating just how effective these 2nd generation floating tidal energy systems can be."
