

Access to reliable resources and expertise
 Atlantic Entrepreneurship Centre (AEC) at Acadia University is undertaking two new pilot projects this upcoming academic year, including a formalized partnership to attract youth and entrepreneurs into the fields of computer science, digital creativity and technology. AEC will also pilot two five-day intensive and immersive workshops for 10 entrepreneurial teams to test prototype designs and find market solutions to grow their business ideas. These projects will help small and medium sized enterprises to thrive, stimulating the regional economy and contributing to a vibrant Nova Scotia business community. That is why the Government of Canada is supporting the **Acadia Entrepreneurship Centre (AEC)** to continue its work delivering essential advisory, training, innovation and incubation programming to hundreds of seasoned and first-time entrepreneurs.

\$4-Million support for Indigenous Games
 The Government of Canada is providing a contribution of more than \$4 million to support the Halifax 2020 North American Indigenous Games, which will also include Millbrook as a venue for several events. Of this amount, Sport Canada is providing up to \$3.8 million for the planning and delivery of the NAIG, through Sport Canada's Hosting Program, and the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA) is providing \$500,000 through the Canadian Experiences Fund.
