PART 2: Conclusion of Colchester Community Workshops Presentation

In last month's issue we published Part 1 of Holly Kennedy's presentation to Colchester Council on behalf of the Colchester Community Workshops. In this issue we include the remainder of her presentation as follows:

The CCW is overcrowded; there is a waiting list for participation and some programs are being hampered because of a lack of facilities.

Essentially the CCW is hoping to develop a capital plan to raise \$4.5-Million to expand the Arthur Street facility and include the former Halliday Centre property and buildings.

Background

2012 - Recreation Services began to look at getting more people active and approached the Department of Health and Wellness to partner in a program. This went hand in hand with CCW's adoption of the MPAL (Municipal Physical Activity Plan).

2013 - Town of Truro and the Municipality partnered to apply for a grant to have funds to allow youth to access the RECC. Received \$20,000 and \$5,000 of that was used to develop a needs assessment.

2014 - Needs assessment was completed - Titled: Recreation Needs Assessment for Families Where Cost is a barrier to Participation". Needs assessment focused on: What is Working Well in Communities; Challenges to Participation; Suggested Supports or Improvements and Opportunities to Support Physical Activity.

2014 to Present - Apply each year to Department of Community, Culture and Heritage for funding to be applied for schools and special needs group to access facilities. currently receive \$20,000 for this project. In the second year opened the opportunity for schools to access their facilities in their home regions.

2014 to Present - The recreation budget includes \$30,000 per year to have groups and programs through our 3 local arenas. This combined with the funding received from the province allows a lot of programming opportunities in those facilities. The municipality has been calling this program Facility Access.

2015 - Developed a committee to look at Inclusion and Access and how to get more people active and more people involved in programs. This committee was developed out of the findings from the above needs assessment that was completed in 2014.

2016 - Included special needs groups and the local Canadian Mental Health association in the application process for facility access, expanded the area of funding to including special needs groups not just youth.

2016 - Reached out to Five Islands and began working with a walking group out there and the municipality rents the Five Islands Fire hall and use that facility in the winter months for the community to use for their walking program.

2017 - One of the items that came out of the Inclusion and Access committee was the need for residents to have access to the RECC and other facilities within the Town. The committee applied to the United Way of Colchester, looking for funding to bring people into the down core from 3 areas in the county.

Program Information - Access to Facilities - Goal of the Facility Access Program:

Increase the number of free, less structured opportunities for children, youth, families, and older adults at sport and recreation facilities. In doing so, increase the utilization of sport and recreation facilities by members of the community who were not previously accessing these facilities.

Increase physical activity levels among segments of the population for whom access is a barrier to participation.

Each September - sends letters to all schools in the Colchester /Truro area and special needs groups to apply for funding through the facility access funding program. Each school is eligible for \$1,000 for the program.

Special needs groups are eligible for \$500.

Groups apply for the funding and submit back to the Municipality.
