

## Taylor Offering for District 10

Londonderry resident Rebecca Taylor has announced her intention to seek a seat on Colchester council.

Taylor believes her 25 years of experience in community economic development will go far with voters looking to fill the vacancy left by Tom Taggart when he became MLA in the recent provincial election.

Taylor's career has largely been spent working for municipal and provincial government departments that create employment and build tourism. While working for the Town of Amherst in 2019, Taylor won a national tourism marketing award from the Economic Developers Association of Canada.

In her role as business development officer, she developed a physician recruitment campaign that brought five new doctors to Cumberland County in its first year. It's a success she says she would like to repeat in her own community.

"If there's one thing I know would improve quality of life for families and seniors in my community," says Taylor, "it would be having access to a family doctor or nurse practitioner."

Taylor would also like to follow the example of other rural communities that have set up fully equipped community health clinics so new family doctors and nurse practitioners can set up practice easily.

Locally, Taylor has volunteered teaching outdoor skills to Girl Guides, as well as serving on the West Colchester Community Development Association, the Along the Shore Community Health Board, and the WCCS School Advisory Council.

In 2013, she secured a \$10,000 grant to set up an after-school activity program called "Thrive After the Bell" for pre-teen girls in West Colchester.

Many also know Taylor as a small business owner and the founder of Pearl & Daisy Natural Soap Company, the award-winning venture she started in her basement. "Over the nine years that I ran the company, what I'm most proud of is providing local women with flexible employment that helped them with their work-life balance."

When considering what she would bring to the job if elected, Taylor says she has no shortage of ideas.

"One of the things I'd like to see is a work experience program that teaches skills in the trades while helping seniors with free home repairs and maintenance." The program would be modeled after similar programs Taylor has coordinated to help farmers hire agricultural workers.
