Electronic Voting

Electors may vote in advance of Election Day either, on-line or telephone, commencing 8:30 A.M., Monday, October 7th and running continuously until 7 P.M., Saturday October 19, 2024.

Voting Kiosk

Vote on-line at the Voter Kiosk in the Municipal Building, 1 Church St, Truro. October 7 through October 18, 830 A.M. - 4 P.M. and October 19, 8 A.M. - 7 P.M. (excluding weekends and holidays)
