NOVA SCOTIA
New Traffic Safety Act
Introduced

A new Traffic Safety Act was
introduced September 23, to
make it easier and faster to im-
plement changes that will
modernize the rules of the
road and improve safety for
Nova Scotians on roads and
highways across the province.
The original Traffic Safety
Act, passed with all-party sup-
port in 2018, was intended to
replace the Motor Vehicle Act
but was not proclaimed. Fol-
lowing consultation on the
draft regulations, it was deter-
mined that implementation
would be too complex and
take too long. It will be re-
pealed.
The new act will allow for
easier updates and clarify lan-
guage. It will also: protect
pedestrians, motorcyclists,
construction workers and
other vulnerable users; imple-
ment distracted driving rules
that address current technol-

ogy; create a framework for in-
clusive cyclist rules of the road
in regulations; update lan-
guage and responsibilities for
municipal traffic authorities;
create a framework to im-
prove child passenger safety,
driver visibility and vehicle
condition standards and allow
for clearer rules for emergency
vehicles, school buses and
emerging vehicle types.
The government will con-
sult directly with partners and
other interest groups over the
coming months, and the act
will be proclaimed and imple-
mented in early 2026. People

In addition to the new leg-
islation, Department staff have
been working to modernize
the systems that support the
Registry of Motor Vehicles and
improve services for citizens.
