

Gunner, the Australian Shepherd, takes the jump with ease as the Glooscap Hot Dogs preform a great show for the crowd.




Josee Roy of The Press Melt was grilling up a delicious Wild Blueberry Cheddar Arugula Grilled Cheese.

Gordon Tucker had everyone's toes tapping as he played a few tunes before the pie eating contest.




Karlee Burgess displays one of the Wild Blueberry Festival t-shirts. Tickets are available on the beautifully hand painted Adirondack chair.
