Beach Tours

September 11th and September 14th 1:30 pm - 2:30 pm **First Beach** - Join a guided tour from the Fundy Geological Museum to visit the nearby First Beach to have a unique Bay of Fundy tidal experience. Hear the stories of the famous Bay of Fundy, from the history of its effects on the local community and coastline, and explore the rocky beach to search for special rocks or minerals. This is a great introduction to the Bay of Fundy and the surrounding geology. A great family activity. Please note: Sturdy footwear is required. This is a rocky beach, with moderate uneven surface. Bring water and sunscreen, and dress for weather conditions; it is usually cooler along the coast. **Cost** Museum Admission plus \$10.00 per person. Ages 12 and under free (accompanied by an adult).

September 27th - 1 pm - 3 pm meet at Museum at 12:45 pm **Guided Tour - Wasson Bluff: Jurassic Dinosaur Site** \$20 PER PERSON Children 12 and under free. Description: Join the Curator for this special guided tour of the important dinosaur research site at Wasson Bluff. Walk on the ocean floor and travel back in time while looking at the rocks in the cliff that were formed 200 million years ago. The tour provides a special behind the scenes experience to dinosaur research that is ongoing right here in Nova Scotia's Bay of Fundy. Saturday, October 21 - Election Date (if necessary)

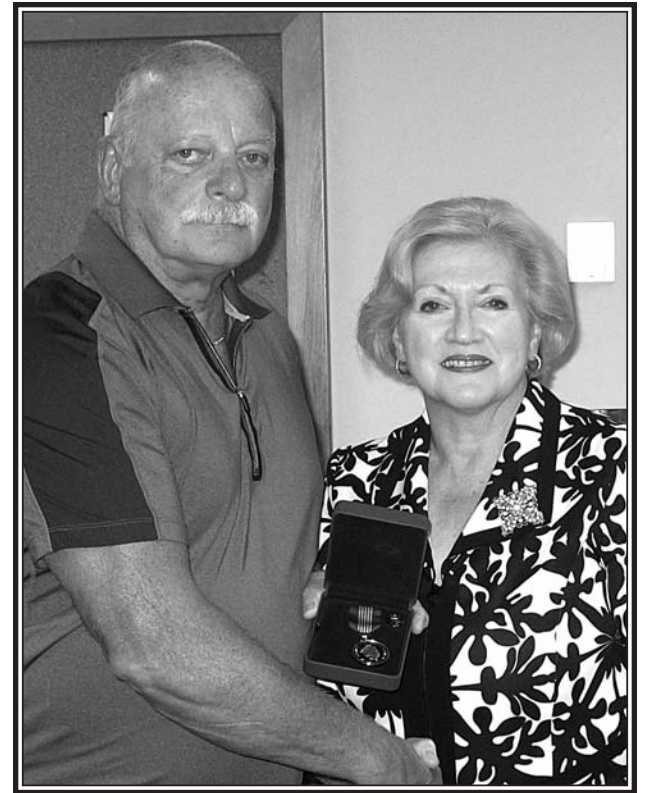
Council committee approved October 21, 2017 as the election date and the CAO be delegated to hire Lorraine Dawson as the returning officer.
