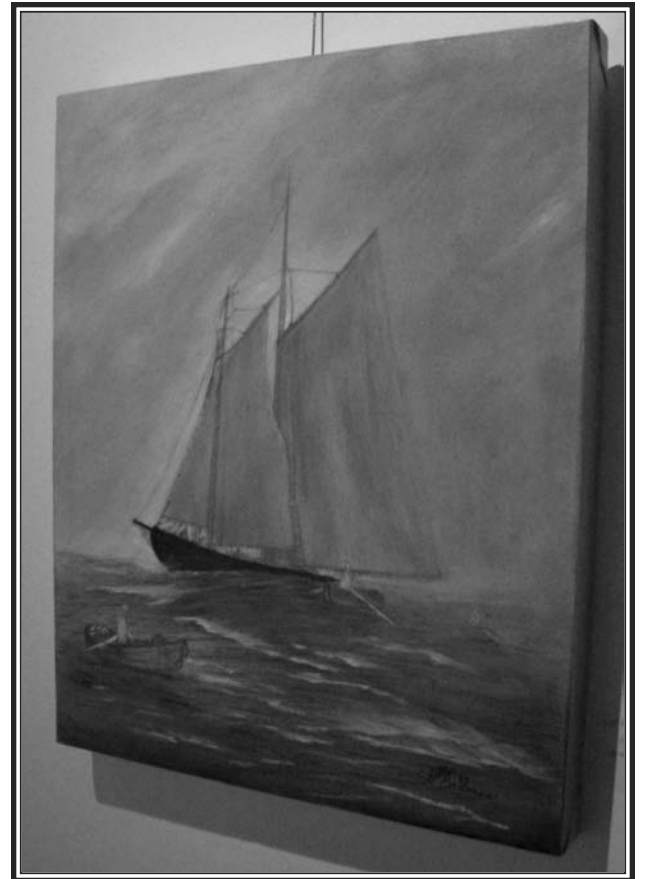
Hopewell, Pictou county.
