11 items added to Committee Agenda

A total of 11 items were added to the agenda of Colchester's council committee meeting on August 9th, with four of the 11 slated for committee's closed session. The added items for discussion included: Ground Search & Rescue; 4-H barn; FCM's Jordan Mission; FORCE Tidal Turbine; Great Village Post Office, Bees, plus two items on Negotiations and two items dealing with personnel matters for the closed session.

Discussion on Colchester Ground Search and Rescue was initiated from the August 7th presentation by the group, who presented the outstanding details from last winter's budget consideration. (More detailed information in separate story). Council committee approved a recommendation for council's meeting on August 30th to increase annual funding from \$23,500 to \$35,000.

The 4-H Barn has been topic before council on several occasions for this fiscal year. (See separate story elsewhere in this issue). Clarification on a certain clause in the lease with the province has satisfied council's concerns, with result council committee



recommended at the monthly meeting on August 30th an amount of \$30,000 be provided to the Colchester 4-H Council immediately, then discuss completing the original request for \$100,000 at a later date.

The FCM's Mission with Jordan, introduced previously by Councillor Taggart, was back to provide confirmation of additional information. Councillors Taggart and Boutillier will be part of a trip to Jordan in September, while Darlene Proctor, from the Municipal Solid Waste Facility will be part of another segment of the mission in October and November.

Colchester has been partnered with Yorkton, Saskatchewan in the FCM initiative. There is no cost to the municipality as all costs relevant to the project will be covered by Global Affairs Canada (formerly External Affairs). In its entirety, the mission is a five year project. In due course,
